The Fulbright U.S. Student Program awards approximately 2,200 full scholarships annually to students for a year of study, research, or English teaching in any of 140 countries worldwide.

In two weeks, the National and International Scholarship Program will be hosting information sessions (starting April 5th) for undergraduate students and recent alumni to provide an overview of the Fulbright U.S. Student Program, including eligibility, grant types, and application advice.
