PhD in Anthropology or related area in hand is required by the starting date. Demonstrated evidence of an active research agenda related to the position is required. The position includes a preferred regional expertise in Sub-Saharan Africa or the Middle East. Topical specializations such as Islam, gender or others that complement the department's current strengths are welcome. Experience teaching at the college level in a diverse environment is strongly preferred.

The appointment is anticipated to be for one year but may be renewed depending on departmental needs and positive performance reviews. The successful candidate will teach two courses per semester. This is a 9-month, full-time, non-tenure track position. The salary is competitive and commensurate with experience.
